I feel so safe.

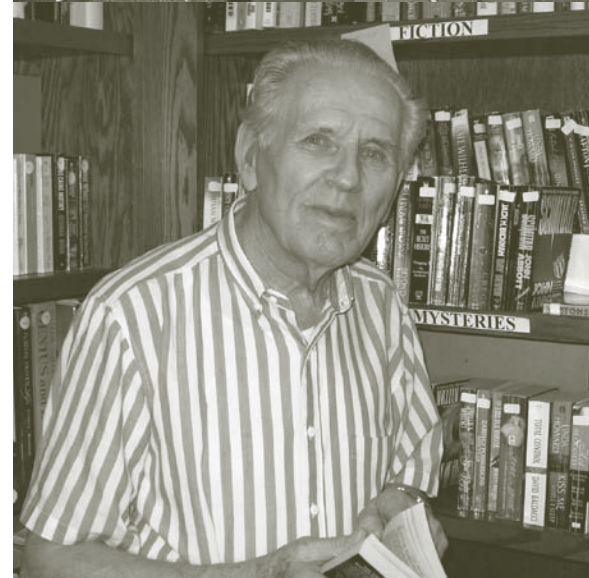
